Morning Drop Off

<u>VERY IMPORTANT</u>. . . As a reminder, please use our drop off circle in the morning when bringing students to school. We ask that you do not park and walk students across the lot, as it slows down the drop off process and causes unnecessary backups on 64th Street. In addition, please try to pull up to the second set of doors (marked Door #2) to allow more families to drop off.

In the event that your child has something too large for them to carry and needs assistance, you may park and help them. If this is the case, please only use the designated crosswalk location to ensure safety.

Morning drop off is 8:20am. There will be no adult supervision prior to 8:20am.

The end of day pick up will be a learning process for our students. Please be patient as we get these processes running smoothly. A few reminders about pick up at the end of the day:

- <u>PINK SHEETS</u>: Please have your pink sheets placed on your vehicle's dash or have your ID ready. You will receive one copy of the pick-up pink sheets. It can be cut in half. If you need another copy of the pink sheet, please let the office know.
- <u>Please DO NOT exit your car or have students get in on the driver's side.</u> If you have to buckle a student into a car seat, please move forward to the area by the loading dock to do so.
- Please do not park your car and come into the building to pick up your child. Please stay in your car and stay in line.

Hand 2 Hand

We would like to offer your student the opportunity to participate in a program at Marshall Elementary called "Hand2Hand". This program helps provide a student with food for the weekends and is intended for families who currently may be experiencing a financial burden. The first backpack is set to be delivered on September 19.

Here's how Hand2Hand will work: At the end of the week, students who are signed up for the program will receive a minimum of 10 food items in a black school logo drawstring bag that will be provided at the first week of participation. These food items will be a combination of breakfast, snacks, lunch and/or dinner items. While the food items are meant for the student, they can be shared among the family as well. (Please note: if your student or another family member has food allergies, it will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to check the contents of the backpack each week to ensure the food doesn't contain ingredients which could cause an allergic reaction).

There is no cost to participate! If you sign your student up to receive Hand2Hand, they will continue to receive the weekly bags each week they are at Marshall Elementary this school year. However, if down the road you no longer need the assistance, simply write a note expressing your desire to discontinue receiving Hand2Hand bags and give this note to the school office.
