Nurses Corner

Stay or Go? When to keep your child home from school!

'Tis the season for germs and illness. Here are a few simple reminders of when to keep your child home from school:

- 1. FEVER (100.4 or higher)-Must be FEVER FREE for 24 hrs without medication.
- 2. Nausea/Vomiting-Typically may return after 24hrs of no symptoms.
- 3. Diarrhea-24-48hrs symptom free.
- 4. Severe Cough-stay home if unable to cover cough and/or perform proper hand hygiene. Stay home if experiencing difficulty breathing with normal activity.
