

5th Grade Suggested Supply List

****No trapper keepers or binders**

- A truckload (or two) of #2 pencils (and this isn't usually enough)
- 3 plastic, two-pocket folders
- 4 composition notebooks (no wires)
- Pencil erasers
- 4 (or more) dry-erase markers
- 1 set of earbuds/headphones and a small case to keep them in
- 1 zippered pencil holder
- 6 (or more) sticky note pads (Post-It or similar brand)
- 4 (or more) glue sticks
- Refillable water bottle
- 1 pack of colored pencils

6th Grade Supply List

***Individual use supplies should be labeled with your child's name.

- (4) two-pocket folders, one for each subject; science, reading art/stem and homeroom/morning work (plastic, three-hole punched prongs)
- (2) one-inch binders with pockets (math and social studies)
- (2) 5-tab dividers (math and social studies)
- (10+) #2 pencils (extra lead if mechanical)
- Extra erasers
- Pencil pouch or case (zipper and three-hole punched if possible)
- 4+ colors of highlighters
- (6+) packs of sticky notes (used all year)
- Earbuds (for Chromebook use)
- Colored pencils
- (1) wide-ruled spiral notebook for math notes (single subject, 100+ pages)
- (2) composition notebooks for writing and reading (100+ sheets)
- Glue sticks
- Reusable water bottle
- Band: (1) one-inch binder with pockets
- Choir: a folder with three prongs and pockets
- Orchestra: (1) one-inch binder with pockets

These items would also be helpful:

- Scientific calculator (Texas Instruments, model# TI30 XIIS solar, TI20 XIIB battery. Available at Meijer, Target, Walmart, etc.)
- Agenda book if it helps your student's learning style. You can find the daily agenda posted on Schoology too.
- Fine-tip colored markers

These items would also be nice for classroom donations:

- Facial tissues
- Anti-bacterial wipes
- Band-aids
- Sticky notes
- Paper towels
- Highlighters
